SWIMMING LESSONS

According to the CDC children ages 1-4 who participate in formal swimming lessons are 88% less likely to drown. Let us help your children learn to be safe and strong swimmers! Registration for lessons is available at <https://splashpoolservices.com/swimming-lessons/> after May 15th.

Group Lesson Session Dates:

Session 1 June 7-June 17

Session 2 June 21-July 1

Session 3 July 12-July 22

Session 4 July 26-August 5

The second Friday of each session will only be used for make-up classes in the event of a full class cancellation.

Group Lessons are participation based. Classes will only run if there are at least 3 swimmers registered for each full session. If the class you registered for does not run due to low enrollment you have the option of applying your enrollment

to a future session, receiving 2 vouchers for free private lessons or a refund. The vouchers are good for 1 year and can be redeemed at Splash Swim School OR Thompson River Ranch.

Classes run between 9:30am-11am each session. Specific class times are set prior to each session. You will be notified of your specific class time(s) no later than the Saturday prior to each session.

Private and semi-private lessons are also available. These are 1:1 or 2-3:1 lessons that are scheduled at your convenience. They are guaranteed to run. Please speak with the pool manager to schedule lessons.

POOL ACCESS

To decrease liability and provide a more secure atmosphere for your family the Metro District will be continuing the use of our Splash! Membership Tracking and Management software. The intent is to help ensure that only residents, in good standing, are using your pool. All pool users will be recorded in the database and will be identified by their photo, checking in and out, during each pool visit. This provides accurate record keeping which allows us to work together to determine adequate staffing. Each household is required to submit the attached demographics form and have photos taken before using the pool.

SWIMMING AND SAFETY

Drowning remains the second leading cause of accidental death for children ages 1-14 in the United States.

Although our lifeguards are provided to assist you with supervising your swimmers, please remember that you are ultimately responsible for the safety of your family and your guests. There is no substitute for your ACTIVE SUPERVISION!

Swimmers who are dependent on floatation devices to swim must be accompanied by a guardian who is in the water within one arms reach, **ACTIVELY WATCHING THEM.**



We strive to promote pool safety and prevent accidents around your facility through active supervision, facility safety checks, safety education, swimming lessons and enforcement of pool rules. It is only through a partnership between your family and the Splash staff that we are able to maintain a safe, relaxing and enjoyable environment for your family and guests.

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

POOL RULES

- The pool is for the use of Thompson River Ranch Homeowners only.
 - *The gate is to remain closed and locked at all times.*
- **Pool key cards are required to enter the facility.**
- **DIVING IS NOT PERMITTED IN ANY AREA OF THE POOL.**
- Swimmers who are dependent on flotation devices must be actively supervised by an adult who is in the pool within an arm's reach.
- No running, no glass, no smoking, no alcohol in facility.
- Profane language is not allowed in facility.
- Children 10 and older are allowed to swim unaccompanied by an adult as long as they can pass a swim test.
- The lifeguard may ask anyone who is a discipline problem to leave the pool.
- "Restbreak" is called 10 minutes prior to each hour. During this time only swimmers over the age of 18 are allowed in the pool. *Infants are permitted only if they are being held by their caregiver.*
- Neither the District nor Splash is responsible for any loss or damage to personal property.
- Swimming diapers are required. Neither cloth or disposable diapers are allowed in either pool.
- Swimmers in the wader pool must be accompanied by a guardian at all times.
- Flotation devices are permitted at the lifeguard's discretion.
- Bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, etc. must be kept outside the pool gates.
- Music must be kept at reasonable sound levels.
- Dispose of trash properly.
- No pets.
- Guests must be accompanied by a member at ALL TIMES.
- Anyone in the pool area when the pool is closed is considered trespassing and is **subject to prosecution.**

POOL PARTIES AND GUESTS

Your family and friends are welcome to enjoy the pool with you!

Thompson River Ranch homeowners, 18 years of age and older, may bring up to 4 guests to the pool during regular swimming hours.

If you plan on having more than 4 guests during one visit to the pool, please speak with the pool manager to arrange your gathering. You may be asked to pay for an additional lifeguard for your group.

Please schedule your pool event at least one week in advance with the pool manager.

" Guests must be accompanied by a pool member, and must check in with the lifeguard upon arrival.

" The pool facility **may not** be reserved for private events.

Please remember that you are ultimately responsible for your family's guests.

Make sure you are confident in the swimming abilities of your guests.

INCLEMENT WEATHER AND LIGHTNING

If the outside temperature is below 65 degrees the pool will be closed and the lifeguard will leave the facility (no lifeguard on duty). A sign will be posted on the gate to inform members of the closure. *Follow us on Facebook and Instagram to stay current on pool closures.*

In the event of a thunder and/or lightning storm, the lifeguards will adhere to the **National Lightning Safety Institute** policy & require all swimmers to exit the water AND



pool grounds for 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder.

If the storm hinders swimming for 60 minutes, or if the bottom of the pool cannot be seen due to heavy rain, the pool will close until the storm has subsided.

For the safety of pool members and their guests the staff has the authority to close the facility during any thunder or lightning storm.
